IVAR constructs and operates municipal facilities for water, waste water and general waste. Their vision is to secure the region's most competitive water, waste water and waste services. The company is owned by the municipalities of Finnøy, Gjesdal, Hå, Klepp, Kvitsøy, Randaberg, Rennesøy, Sandnes, Sola, Stavanger and Time with a total population of approx. 300 000. The best drinking water comes straight from the tap IVAR supplies drinking water to all the municipal owners. Their drinking water is subject to the most stringent requirements related to the quality of hygienic water. They treat waste water IVAR receives and treats waste water from the ownership municipalities.
